



The payments have to be made in the first week of the commencement of the financial year.
5. If the second party fails to make payment of charges or is found to be irregular, the first party will intimate to the APPCB (Regional Office) and then stop collection of e-Waste after 15 days of such intimation. In such cases the discretion for re-enrolment of the second party lies within the first party after the receipt of all accumulated arrears with interest.
